It is important to update TPMS scan tools regularly to have access to latest vehicle relearn coverage

Relearn challenges may occur if:

- The wrong make, model, year, sub-model or trim level is selected in the tool
- The relearn is not performed in entirety
- The vehicle is prematurely driven
- A tool with incompatible software is used

For many vehicles, the IDs must be written to the vehicle via OBDII using a properly formatted TPMS scan tool.

If an error occurs during installation or the relearn process, the sensors may need to be unlocked. This function can be found on the compatible scan tools shown below:
